



15 April 2021 - 15 October 2021




National Emergency Response Mechanism

* The National Emergency Response Mechanism for unaccompanied minors in precarious living conditions launched the telephone line in April 2021 and assumed the accommodation of unaccompanied minors in June of the same year. Until the end of August, the Mechanism received 1,176 calls, which concern 920 different cases of unaccompanied minors, out of which 892 concern accommodation requests, 21 legal aid, and 7 other requests.








